

Northeast Equestrian Series

The Northeast Equestrian Series (NES) is a schooling show series located on Long Island. The series is founded on the principle of bringing the local horse community together through safe competition, comradery, and horse/rider development. The horse show divisions are hosted at the following equestrian facilities; Hidden Pond Stables, Bohemia Equestrian Center (managed by Islip Horseman's Association), Old Field Farm, and Country Farms. All registered participants in Northeast Equestrian Series divisions will be eligible to compete at the NES Finals held at Old Field Farm each fall. NES riders and horses are also eligible for year-end awards based on the accumulation of points throughout the show season. The celebration of the horses, riders and awards is held during the Annual Northeast Equestrian Series Banquet.


COUNTRY FARMS SERIES AWARDS

Series awards will be given out at the end of the season to Grand Champion and Reserve of each division. To be eligible for our awards, riders must compete in at least two shows in the same division. No horse substitutions will be permitted in hunter or jumper classes. Points will follow the horse in hunter and jumper divisions regardless of the rider. Points will follow the rider in equitation divisions regardless of the horse.

Directions to Country Farms

Heading Eastbound on the LIE: Exit 65. Take service road straight, going past the 1st light at Horseblock Road to the second light which is Bellport Avenue. Make left on to Bellport Avenue. Follow Bellport Avenue over LIE light and past stop sign. Continue straight on Bellport to Country Farms on left side. Drive up to the middle of the gates and they will open automatically.

Heading Westbound on the LIE: Exit 66. Continue straight through first light staying on service road. Take service road to the second light which is Bellport Avenue and make a right. Stay on Bellport Avenue past the next stop and go straight to Country Farms on left. Drive up to the middle of the gates and they will open automatically.



<u>General Information / Rules & Regulations</u>

- Riders must compete in a minimum of two shows to be eligible for a year end award.
- Riders wishing to be eligible for a year end award with Northeast Equestrian Series are required to pay a \$5 fee at each show attended per division in order for points to be counted.
- Points are equally valued at each show. 1st-7pts, 2nd-5pts, 3rd-4pts, 4th- 3pts, 5th-2pts, and 6th-1pt
- Trainers, coaches and riders are to use discretion when choosing divisions in order to ensure fairness to all participants.
- Horse and rider combinations are not restricted to showing in the same divisions for no more than two years.
- Classes offered herein which are covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule unless stated otherwise.
 Points won at these shows will count toward the year end awards.
- Country Farms Equestrian Center and all personnel and entities connected thereto shall in no case be held liable or responsible for any loss or damage to animal, person, or property which may occur for any reason, and this is a condition of entry upon the show grounds.
- All fees must be paid and entry blanks signed as required prior to the giving out of any numbers. REFUNDS WITH VETERINARIAN'S CERTIFICATE ONLY.
- Riders must wear proper riding attire. ASTM/SEI approved safety riding helmet must be in place when riding anywhere on the show grounds.
- Warm-up. The warm-up fee is \$10.00 which must be paid prior to entering the ring. All riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved safety riding helmet. Up to 10 riders will be allowed at a time for 10 minutes.
- Schooling without entering a class must pay a \$30 schooling fee and be issued a schooling pass.
- Classes with insufficient entries will be cancelled or combined. Management reserves the right unto itself to cancel, combine, run sweepstakes, or substitute classes at its discretion.
- No dogs allowed.
- Pre-entries must be received by the Thursday prior to show date, no later than 5:00 pm.
- Pre-entry fees: \$25.00 per class and \$35 for Mashall & Sterling classes. Post-entry fees: \$30.00 per class and \$40 for M&S classes.
 There is a office fee of \$10.00 per entry.
- SCRATCH FEE after closing date fee: \$50.00 per division.
- Management reserves the right to add or change Judge if necessary.
- Management may elect to use a posted jumping order if necessary in the event that a posted jumping order is used, rides will be determined on a rotational basis. Back to back rounds are encouraged where available. If posted jumping orders are not used, the one-minute rule to enter the ring will be strictly enforced.



Hunter Divisions

Classes to be judged on the horse's performance, soundness, manners, consistency and suitability to purpose.

Cross-Rail Hunter *NES*

Open to horses and ponies who are not entered in any other division with fences higher than 18 inches. Simple changes allowed. To be judged over a course of fences with a change of direction. Fences don't exceed 18".




Pleasure Division *NES*

Open to horses and ponies. Simple changes allowed.

- 76. Pleasure Equitation: To show at a walk and trot in both directions.
- 77. Pleasure Hunter: To show at a walk, trot, and canter in both directions. To be judged on performance and soundness.
- 78. Pleasure Crossrail: Walk, Trot, Canter. To jump 2 cross rails, trotting permitted.







Equitation Divisions

Leadline Equitation *NES*

Open to riders 8 and under who have not shown in any classes requiring riders to walk, trot and canter. Riders cannot cross enter into any other division.

Leadline: Walk - Ask a Question
 Leadline: Walk/Trot
 Leadline: Walk/Trot/2-Point at a Walk

Pre-Walk Trot Equitation *NES*

Open to riders 10 & under who have started trotting independently. Riders to be accompanied by an adult off lead. Riders may not enter any other division. To be judged on suitability or mount to rider and rider's form.

- 5. Pre-Walk/Trot: Walk Trot
- 6. Pre-Walk/Trot: Walk Trot 2 Point

Pre-Special Beginner *NES*

Open to riders 12 and under who have recently started trotting independently. Riders cannot cross enter into any other division. Diagonals count but riders can get assistance in getting them.

> 7.Pre-Spec Beg: Walk/Trot 8.Pre-Spec Beg: Walk/Trot - 2 point 9.Pre-Spec Beg: Individual Figure Eight 10.Pre-Spec Beg: Riders go over 2 ground poles

Special Beginner *NES*

Open to riders under 18 who have not competed in a higher division. Riders cannot cross enter into any other division. Leads not to count.

11.Special Beg: Walk/Trot 12.Special Beg : Walk/Trot 2-POINT 13.Special Beg: Walk/Trot/Individual canter 14.Special Beg: Single Cross-rail (Trot or Canter)

Junior/Adult Beginner *NES*

Open to all riders. Riders cannot cross enter into any division at this show except Cross Rail Hunter. A Section Junior B Section Adult 18 & older.

15.Jr/Adult Beginner: Walk/Trot 16.Jr/Adult Beginner: Walk/Trot/Canter (No more than 7 to canter at once) 17.Jr/Adult Beginner: Twice around the outside. 18.Jr/Adult Beginner: Twice around the outside.



Equitation Divisions Cont.

Short Stirrup Equitation *NES*

Open to riders under 12 years old who have not shown over fences 18" in this or any previous (schooling /rated) show season. Riders cannot cross enter into any division at this show except cross rail hunters. Simple changes are allowed. No more than 4 to canter at once. Trotting Permitted over fences.

Long Stirrup Equitation

Open to riders 13 years and older who have not shown over fences 18" in this or any previous (schooling /rated) show season. Riders cannot cross enter into any division at this show except cross rail hunters. Simple changes are allowed. No more than 4 to canter at once. Trotting Permitted over fences.

All Age Equitation *NES*

Open to junior and adult riders who have not shown in any division in this or previous (schooling/rated) show season that required showing over fences higher that 2'. Simple changes allowed.

Novice Equitation

Open to horses and ponies who are not entered in any other division with fences higher than 3'. Simple changes allowed. To be judged over a course of fences with a change of direction. Fences don't exceed 2'3".

37. Maclay: Over Fences 50% and 50% Under Saddle.



Jumper Divisions

.60M Jumper *NES*

Open to any horse or pony. Fences 2'0" with change of direction. Rider and horses are not to cross enter into any other jumper division. USEF rules apply. Major faults to count.



Open to any horse and ponies. Fences 2'6"- with changes of direction. Rider and horses are not to cross enter into any other jumper division. USEF rules apply. Major faults to count.

The League

Entry Fee: \$35

Pre-Child/Adult 2' Hunter Classic

<u>Class #: 100</u>

Open to Jr. and Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Rider may not cross enter into any USEF-rated Hunter Divisions. Exception USHJA Hunter up to 2'6". One class – two rounds

Pre-Children's/Adult 2' Medal

<u>Class #: 101</u>

Open to Junior and Amateur riders on horses or ponies who are eligible to compete in the Pre-Child/Adult Hunters. No cross entry of rider into any other class with fence heights of 2'6" or higher. The same horse/pony must be used in all phases. Ponies may not cross-enter into the League Pony Medal sections.

Bit O' Straw Hunter Classic – 2'6"

<u>Class #: 102</u>

Open to Junior or Amateur riders. No cross entry of horse/pony or rider into The League's Children's Horse, Pony or Adult Hunter Classic. No cross entry of rider into any rated Hunters or any class with fences of 3' or higher.

Children's/Adult 2'6" Medal


<u>Class #: 103</u>

Open to Adult Amateur Riders who are not competing at the same show in any class with fences exceeding 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 2'6"' including at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count.

Intermediate Children's/Adult .80m Jumper Classic

<u> Class #: 104</u>

Horse/Rider combination must have entered in at least one other jumper class at the show and may not show in any class with fences 1.0m or higher. Table II.2.a/b. 0.80m.



Western Equitation

Beginner Western Equitation

<u>(Walk-Trot Only)</u> For riders who are comfortable at the walk and trot but not yet ready to canter. Judged on rider position, accuracy, and effectiveness of aids.

- 64. Walk Equitation Riders demonstrate correct position and control at the walk and trot.
- 65. Walk-Trot Equitation on the Rail Emphasis on smooth transitions and maintaining proper form.

66. Walk-Trot Equitation Challenge – Demonstrate a figure eight pattern

67. Walk-Trot Pattern – A straightforward pattern including transitions, straight lines, and circles.

Intermediate Western Equitation

<u>(Walk-Trot-Canter)</u> For riders who are comfortable cantering in a group and maintaining control through transitions.

- 68. Walk-Trot Equitation Riders perform basic rail work at walk and trot.
- 69. Walk-Trot-Canter Equitation Judged on rider position and smoothness at all three gaits.
 - 70. Equitation Challenge Introduces more precise transitions and controlled maneuvers.
- 71. Pattern Class Includes all three gaits with a simple halt, circle, and back-up.

Open Western Equitation

For experienced riders who can perform more precise maneuvers with balance and control. If not enough entries will be combined with Intermediate.

- 72. Walk-Trot Equitation Riders perform basic rail work at walk and trot.
- 73. Walk-Trot-Canter Equitation Focus on effectiveness of aids and smoothness at all three gaits.
 - 74. Equitation Challenge Incorporates more precise transitions and patterns while maintaining form.
- 75. Pattern Class A more advanced pattern with transitions, circles, and a halt with a backup.
